# Winter Parking Ordinance in Effect!

As of November 1, 2023, overnight parking on Bountiful City streets is prohibited between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. so our awesome snow plow drivers can safely and efficiently clean our streets! This ordinance is in effect through March 31, 2024

#### Flood Hazard Information

The US Congress has mandated all federally insured lenders to require flood insurance on properties that are located in "Special Flood Hazard Areas" which are those areas determined to have a 1% or greater chance of flooding in any given year. The Federal Emergency Management

Agency (FEMA) issues maps known as Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM), to help determine the flood

risks for real property. FIRMs can be viewed online using FEMA's Map Service Center:

# Leaf Pick-up

As an extra service, Bountiful City workers will pick up leaves from your yard that are left on your curb - not on the street or in the gutter. It is best to bag the leaves if possible. This service is provided as long as the crews - who also maintain our roads, plow the

snow and pick up the regular garbage and recycling - are available. If yours do not get picked

up, it's best to bag them to put in your garbage bin so they don't get stuck at the bottom!
