

Construction Update June 9, 2017


Project Update:

Crews are completing final work items and quality reviews. This process has determined that a few concrete panels will need to be replaced as warranty work and at no additional cost to the project or public. This will ensure the best and longest lasting roadway surface is provided before the project completes.

Of the over 11,000 cubic yards of concrete (1000+ truck loads) placed along 400 North, just 55 cubic yards, or 0.5% of the total concrete on the project will be replaced across several locations along 400 North.

Anticipated Impacts:

Beginning Monday, June 12, crews will close lanes 24 hours/day for approximately 10 days near each replacement location while the individual segments of concrete are removed, replaced, and cure. Motorists can expect short lane closures and some additional congestion for approximately 10 days at each location or until the concrete reaches strength. The map below details replacement locations.



Bountiful City Park:

Crews are completing sod installation this week near the park. Park visitors and pedestrians are asked to stay off the turf near the 400 North sidewalk to allow it to properly establish.

Concrete panel replacement will not occur near Bountiful City Park until the week of June 19 to avoid impacting the Bountiful Rotary *Coats for Kids Car Show & Cruisin'* event.

Landscape Restoration & Sod:

Sod is being placed on the corridor this week and next. We ask property owners & residents to please begin watering directly after installation is complete to ensure the sod survives. This is the final landscaping activity and maintenance of the sod is now the responsibility of the home/property owner.

All paving and work activities are subject to change due to weather, material, equipment, or utility delays.

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
