### **Construction Update** **October 20, 2016**

Traffic has been shifted to the new concrete throughout the project area.  
Please be prepared for a new traffic configuration.

Concrete paving has shifted to the day time  
due to cold temperatures at night.

#### **400 North- Main Street to 500 West:**

- Today, crews are paving in the workzone between Main Street and 150 West.
- Crews are lowering a gas line on the south side of 400 North between Main Street and 200 West. Material placement and final grading is scheduled through October in preparation for paving in November.
  - Business access to Bountiful Antiques, Gordon's Copyprint LC, and FiiZ Drinks will be maintained during this work.
  - Residents can expect an increase in noise and traffic during this time.
  - Intermittent side street closures up to two hours may occur while work moves through intersections.
- Crews plan to pour concrete on the far east side of Main Street during the day Friday October 28.

#### **400 North- 500 West to I-15:**

- Beginning next Monday, October 24 crews are scheduled to remove asphalt and begin excavation on the south side of 400 North from I-15 to 500 West. This activity will be followed by materials hauling, placement, and grading in preparation for concrete paving in November.
  - Access will be maintained, but intermittent interruptions are likely.

## Project Description:

The project will reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance. Additionally, the project will:

- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street.
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow.

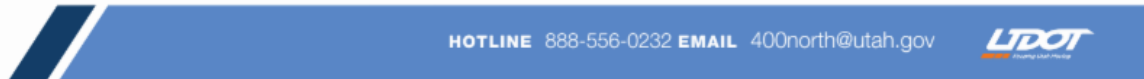
## Project Impacts:

- 400 North is reduced to one lane in each direction between Main Street and I-15.
- Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect access restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise during the day and at night.
- Pedestrians should be alert, follow posted signs, and use an alternate route when possible.
- Through the duration of this project, trash pick-up days have been changed to every Friday between 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the entire corridor. To maintain trash removal while work continues, crews will move trash bins to the other side of the street every Friday morning at 8 a.m. To ensure bins are moved, residents must place their bins on the sidewalk by 6 p.m. the evening prior.
