NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

This letter contains important information about a construction project near your home or business. Please read carefully.

Dear Resident or Business Owner:

Questar Gas is planning construction to replace a section of underground natural gas pipeline in the South Davis County known as Feeder Line 117 (FL117). This letter is to inform you about work we will be doing over the next several months on a section of pipe near your home or business. This work is necessary to maintain the safety and reliability of our system and to keep pace with customer growth in Davis County.

The section of FL117 near you slated for replacement is located in North Salt Lake, Woods Cross and Bountiful. It runs along Highway 89 from Eagle Ridge Dr. to 3100 South and then on several residential streets ending near 150 East and 1500 South. (Please see map on other side of this letter for the exact route.) To expedite construction, multiple crews will be working simultaneously at various locations during the project. Crews may also work at night and on weekends. Construction is scheduled to begin May 16, 2016, and is expected to be completed by the end of October 2016.

Questar Gas and its contractor, Canyon Pipeline, are committed to completing this work as quickly and with as little inconvenience to local businesses and residents as possible. To provide room for crews and equipment, some temporary lane restrictions and road closures can be expected. Every effort will be made to maintain access to businesses and driveways in construction zones at all times. No interruption to residents' natural gas service is anticipated during this project.

Public safety is of paramount importance to us. You can do your part to ensure that construction proceeds safely and on schedule by driving carefully in construction zones and keeping children away from open trenches and construction activity. Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible. We appreciate your patience.
