

S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful; 800 West to Main Street

400 North Improved Project Update- May 26th, 2016

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will be resurfacing S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful from 800 West to Main Street to increase the life the roadway.

Construction Activities for May 26-June 2, 2016

North- Main Street to 500 West (Phase 1): Work will begin on the north side of the street, starting at Main Street and moving east towards I-15 through June.

This week:

- Crews are hauling and placing materials in preparation for concrete paving as early as June 6. Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
- Concrete paving is expected to begin in early June and will occur at night. Driveways in this segment will be closed for approximately 10 days while the concrete cures. Please begin making preparations to park in an alternate location.
- Through the duration of this project, trash pick-up days have been changed to every Friday between 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the entire corridor. To maintain trash removal while work continues, crews will move trash bins to the other side of the street every Friday morning at 8 a.m. To ensure bins are moved, residents must place their bins on the sidewalk by 6 p.m. the evening prior.

400 North- 500 West to I-15 (Phase 2):

Roadway work in this section is expected to start in mid June.

Bountiful City Waterline Activities:

- The City of Bountiful is continuing to install water lines along the 400 North project corridor. Area residents can expect nighttime water service interruptions and road closures between 200 West and 200 East starting Tuesday, May 31 and continuing through Friday, June 3 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Traffic will be detoured at 200 West.
- All affected properties will be notified by the Bountiful City Water Department before service is interrupted.

Project Description:

The project will reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance. Additionally, the project will:


- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street.
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow.

Project Impacts:

- 400 North reduced to one lane in each direction between Main Street and 500 West.
- Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible.
- Area residents and businesses can expect short-term intermittent driveway interruptions.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise during the day and at night.
- Motorists can reduce delays by using alternate routes, avoiding peak travel times, telecommuting, carpooling or combining trips.
- Pedestrians should be alert and follow posted signs. It is recommended that an alternate route be used.

Project Timeline:

Construction began in mid May and is scheduled to continue through October 2016. This aggressive construction schedule was designed to work around the Bountiful City water line and irrigation project currently underway and complete work in one construction season.
