# S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful; 800 West to Main Street

#### 400 North Improved Project Update- June 23, 2016

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will be resurfacing S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful from 800 West to Main Street to increase the life the roadway.

#### **Construction Activities for June 23- June 30, 2016**

**North- Main Street to 500 West (Phase 1):** Work is ongoing on the north side of the street, starting at Main Street and moving west towards I-15 through June.

#### This week:

- Night time concrete paving work has begun and will continue through July 2nd from 200 West to Main Street. Driveways in this segment will be closed for approximately 10 days while the concrete cures. \*Concrete work scheduled for Friday night will include heavy truck traffic and noise due to compacting machinery.
  - Residents should continue to park in an alternate location while concrete cures.
  - Flaggers will be on-site directing traffic during this work. Expect congestion and traffic delays of up to ten minutes. Use alternate routes when possible.
- Crews will begin placing driveways, curb and gutter from 200 West through Main Street as early as July 6th.
  - Residents should continue to park in an alternate location while concrete cures.
  - o Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
- Crews will begin to shift traffic at Main Street and 200 West as early as June 12th in preparation for pavement work at these intersections on June 15 and 16th.

400 North- 500 West to I-15 (Phase 2):

Work during this phase will begin on the north side of 400 North and move from east to west.

- Crews anticipate shifting traffic onto the south side of 400 North as early as June 27th in preparation for this work.
  - Crews will re-stripe the roadway and shift traffic to the south side with one lane in each direction.
  - o Crews will excavate the roadway and remove asphalt through early July
  - o Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
  - As early as July 5, crews will begin hauling and placing materials in preparation for concrete work through mid July. Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
  - Concrete pouring is expected to begin in early to mid July and will occur at night. Driveways in this segment will be closed for approximately 10 days while the concrete cures. Please begin making preparations to park in an alternate location.

#### **Project Description:**

The project will reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance. Additionally, the project will:


- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street.
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow.

### **Project Impacts:**

- 400 North reduced to one lane in each direction between Main Street and 500 West.
- Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible.
- Area residents and businesses can expect short-term intermittent driveway interruptions.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise during the day and at night.
- Motorists can reduce delays by using alternate routes, avoiding peak travel times, telecommuting, carpooling or combining trips.
- Pedestrians should be alert and follow posted signs. It is recommended that an alternate route be used.
- Through the duration of this project, trash pick-up days have been changed to every Friday between 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the entire corridor. To maintain trash removal while work continues, crews will move trash bins to the other side of the street every Friday morning at 8 a.m. To ensure bins are moved, residents must place their bins on the sidewalk by 6 p.m. the evening prior.

## **Project Timeline:**

Construction began in mid May and is scheduled to continue through October 2016. This aggressive construction schedule was designed to work around the Bountiful City water line and irrigation project currently underway and complete work in one construction season.
