Spring Clean Up

Bountiful's Spring Clean Up dates are April 1-5 2024.



- Items must be out by 7:00 a.m. on your garbage day.
- Bundles, bags or boxes must not exceed 50 lbs.
- Limbs and trees must be cut into five-foot lengths and tied with twine.
- Landfill is free to Bountiful residents (proof of residency required) April 1-13.
- Different crews will be picking up different types of items.
- Construction materials will not be picked up curbside.


