## THE PROJECT WILL:

- Reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow
- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street

# **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This summer, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is working to improve the roadway surface on S.R.106 (400 North) in Bountiful. The 400 North Improvements project will upgrade the pavement, reducing the disruption of maintenance and its overall cost by replacing asphalt with concrete.

# **PROJECT TIMELINE**

Construction will begin in early May of 2016 and is scheduled for completion in the Fall of 2016. This aggressive construction schedule was designed to minimize impacts to the public over the long term. Please see graphic to the right for project timelines and phasing.

### **IMPACTS**

400 North will be reduced to one lane in each direction with turn lanes at the major intersections during construction. Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible. Area residents and businesses can expect short-term intermittent driveway interruptions and construction work during the day and at night to complete this project in 2016. Motorists can reduce delays by using alternate routes, avoiding peak travel times, telecommuting, carpooling or combining trips.
