South Davis Recreation Center

As you drive along 400 North, many of you have seen the great progress being made on the new South Davis Recreation Center. It's very exciting to see the facility being constructed right before our eyes. We also want to report to you what is going on inside the building, which is progressing just as well.

Recently, the cement floor was poured for the new ice arena. It took 21 people from 5:00 a.m. until approximately 3:30 p.m., working together, to make sure the surface was level and that it covered the 17 miles of tubing the refrigeration would go through to freeze the ice.

Hogan Construction is currently focusing their efforts on getting the aquatic areas of the new Rec Center ready for installation of the pools when they arrive from Italy. We are very excited that an indoor family leisure pool with play features, a water slide, and a lazy river will be included in the aquatic area. There will also be a separate indoor competition/lap pool, allowing two events to take place simultaneously. Both pools are made of Myrtha stainless steel with a special PVC lining, and should arrive in Bountiful by the end of August. In an effort to make our goal of completing the Rec Center by late December, the pool contractor is bringing in a certified crew from New Zealand to help with the installation process. We can't wait to get these pools operational so we can offer aquatics to all ages.

We have had a lot of positive comments about the new recreation center and are excited for the Grand Opening. Some of the comments we hear most often are: "It's huge! When is it going to be open? How much is it going to cost?"

This new Rec Center will be a great place for the entire family to enjoy. Charter memberships are now on sale through August 25th (see the price list included in this newsletter). We are hoping to be open sometime in late December of this year. We will keep everyone updated as time goes on. If you have any questions, please give us a call at 298-6220.

- 1) Go to www.xpressbillpay.com. We have partnered with Xpress Bill Pay to provide you with online bill payment service.
- 2) Click on "New to Xpress Bill Pay?" If you've already signed up with Xpress Bill Pay, you can log in with your e-mail address and password.
- 3) Follow the instructions on the screen. You will need a valid e-mail address to create an account.
- 4) Go back to www.XpressBillPay.com and log in using your e-mail address and password. The "Add e-Bills" page appears. Follow the instructions on the screens to add us to your Xpress Bill Pay account.

Once you've created an account, you'll be able to go online at any time to view and pay your bills.

Bountiful City's Fall Cleanup

Our annual fall cleanup is scheduled during the week of Monday, October 9 thru Friday, October 13. On your regular garbage pickup day during that week, city crews will also remove trash and refuse which has been properly bundled, bagged or boxed as described below:

- Limbs and trees must be cut, bundled and tied in 5-foot lengths.
- Bundles, bags or boxes must not exceed 50 lbs.
- Items such as old furniture or appliances should be placed on the drive approach or park strip, not on the street or sidewalk.
- Garbage containers should always be placed out on the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your garbage day.

COMPLIANCE TO FALL CLEANUP REGULATIONS IS MANDATORY. IF YOU CAN NOT MEET THE REGU-LATIONS YOU WILL NEED TO HAUL AWAY THE DEBRIS YOURSELF. The landfill will not charge Bountiful residents
