ADUs in Bountiful City!



Where are ADUs allowed in Bountiful City?

In Bountiful, Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU) are allowed in Single-Family Residential, Multi-Family Residential, and Downtown Mixed-Use Zones, as either an internal (permitted) or detached (conditional) unit. However, ADU shall not be allowed within a duplex or multi-family residential building, or property. The ADU must also meet various criteria, including owner occupancy requirements and specific parking and entrance locations.
