# **City Council Staff Report**

### **Background**

State law UCA 20A-4-301(2)(b)(i) requires that the governing body canvass and officially adopt the election returns no earlier than seven days after nor later than fourteen days after the election.

#### **Analysis**

The "canvass" is a meeting at which the legislative body reviews and verifies the completeness and accuracy of the election results and then adopts them, if and when complete. They would certify the votes cast for and against the ballot proposition voted upon at the election. Under contract previously approved by the Council, the Davis County Clerk/Auditor's Office has already processed/counted the votes cast. The overall voter turnout in Davis Council was just over 78% and about the same for Bountiful.
