Overview:

Assists linemen in the construction, repair, and maintenance of basic power structures for the City of Bountiful Power Department.

Tasks:

Assists linemen in constructing, repairing, patrolling, and maintaining transmission, distribution, and telemetering lines. Loads and unloads line materials from trucks and assembles material on the ground which is used by linemen in construction. Assists linemen in maintaining switch racks, outdoor substation structures, transmission and distribution lines. Passes material to linemen by using a hand line. Refuses distribution lines, set poles, installs cross arms, strings and ties in new lines. Assists Journeyman Linemen on both energized and de-energized lines. Assists in loading and unloading trucks and trailers. Keeps all trucks and tools in clean working order. Assists with power line clearance (cutting and trimming trees) as needed. Assists in handling emergency calls such as power line failures, lines down, and other emergencies which may arise. Must wear a phone/pager and be available for call out at any time of day, year-round, regardless of weather conditions. Performs other duties of a like or lesser grade which may be assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Other Characteristics:

Ability to skillfully use hand tools, read blueprints or drawings of items to be repaired, measure, cut, or otherwise work on materials or objects with great precision. Ability to use arithmetic or shop geometry to figure amounts of material needed, dimensions to be followed and cost of materials.

Will be required to complete an approved four-year Apprentice Lineman schooling and training program. Must be able to pass all written and practical examinations with a minimum score of 80%.

Qualifications:

Must live within 20 minute response time of the Power Department office.
Must pass a drug test and a criminal background check.

Physical Requirements:

Ability to lift 100 lbs. maximum with frequent lifting and/or carrying of objects weighing up to 50 lbs. Requires the ability to perform the following activities: climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, talking, hearing, and seeing. Requires operating aerial devices and the ability to climb poles using climbing equipment. May work on high voltages ranging from 138 KV down, which could cause severe injury. Required to work in all types of construction sites. Required to work outdoors in any weather condition.

Required Licenses and Certifications:

Valid Utah Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

Education and Experience:

High school graduate.
One year experience as a Skilled Groundman or equivalent training.
