Fall Clean Up Week

Bountiful City's Fall cleanup is October 7th through October 11th, 2024. The same restrictions will apply this fall as they did last spring. During that week, on your regular garbage pickup day, city crews will also remove trash and refuse that has been properly bundled, bagged, or boxed. All debris must be bagged, boxed, or bundled. LIMBS AND TREES MUST BE CUT IN 5-FOOT LENGTHS, *BUNDLED AND TIED WITH TWINE*. Bundles, bags, or boxes must not exceed 50 lbs. Please separate metal items from your other debris, as metal recycling crews will be picking up those items. Concrete and construction materials will not be picked up curbside. All items, including old furniture or appliances, must be placed on the drive approach or park strip, away from garbage cans and mailboxes, not on the street or sidewalk. Several special cleanup crews will pick up fall cleanup items, which might come at different times or days than your regular garbage collection. Different crews will be picking up different types of items. All your cleanup items may not be picked up at the same time. Please have your cleanup items out for our crews to pick up before 7:00 a.m. on your regular garbage day.

Also, to assist you in your fall cleanup, the Landfill will not charge a fee to Bountiful residents during the fall cleanup week or the following week. Proof of residency is required. Trash that does not comply with the above restrictions can be taken to the Landfill and disposed of at no charge during cleanup weeks. Landfill fees will remain for concrete and construction materials during the free cleanup weeks. We do not accept hazardous materials, propane tanks, or tires of any kind during the cleanup week or at the Landfill. Household Hazardous Waste cleanup day is a separate event, scheduled for Saturday, October 12th, from 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. at the city shops, located at 950 S 200 W Bountiful, please see the city website for more information.

Compliance with the special cleanup regulations is mandatory. Items that do not meet the above regulations will need to be taken to the landfill by the property owner.
