Night Work Begins This Weekend

Now that Main Street is paved, crews will apply a “micro-seal” on top of the newly placed pavement to seal and protect it. This work will be completed at night to reduce impacts to traffic during daytime hours. **Night work will begin as early as Saturday night at 8 p.m. and will continue through 6 a.m., throughout the next week.**

Nearby residents should expect noise, vibration, and construction lighting; changing traffic patterns; and trucks and equipment entering and exiting the work zone.

Additional work will be completed during daytime hours including raising utilities and grinding the newly placed asphalt to smooth the roadway. Construction is expected to be complete in early August.
