



OFFICIAL NOTICE MUNICIPAL ELECTION

May 1st, 2025

The City of Bountiful will hold a Municipal General Election on November 4, 2025. Offices to be voted upon are Mayor and two (2) City Council members (each office is a four-year term – January 2026 through December 2029).

The candidate filing period is between June 2, 2025, and June 6, 2025, Monday through Friday, except weekends and holidays. A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at 795 South Main Street, Bountiful, UT 84010. There is a \$25.00 filing fee that will be due at the time of filing. If paying by card, please note a 3% processing fee will apply. If you plan to file on Friday, June 6, only cash or check payments will be accepted, as the City's Utilities Department (which processes card payments) will be closed that day.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- Registered Voter in the Bountiful
- Must have resided within Bountiful for 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- Maintain a principal place of residence within Bountiful during the officer's term of office.
- Pay filing fee
- Not convicted of a felony
- Cannot have been declared mentally incompetent.

If you are a military (currently deployed) or overseas citizen eligible to vote in state and local elections, you may register to vote and request a regular absentee ballot for upcoming elections.


