US 89 Preservation 1000 N to Eagle Ridge Drive

Project Overview

UDOT will be performing asphalt maintenance on a four mile corridor on US-89 through Bountiful, West Bountiful, Woods Cross and North Salt Lake (from Eagle Ridge Drive to 1000 North/I-15). The pavement will receive a micro-surface treatment, which will extend the life of the asphalt.

The project will also be upgrading approximately 100 sidewalk pedestrian ramps to become compliant with federal Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Work began on July 5 at the south end of the project limits, and crews plan to work their way north. Approximately 10 pedestrian ramps have already been replaced. Construction work is scheduled for completion by the end of August.

Schedules are subject to change due to materials availability or weather.



What's Coming Up

The next three weeks will focus primarily on the installation of pedestrian ramps. Construction on pedestrian ramps will generally take place Monday through Friday during daytime hours. Some evening and Saturday work may take place as needed. Most work will be staged on side streets so traffic along US 89 isn't impacted.

At the beginning of August, crews will lay a micro-

surface over existing asphalt. This work will take place overnight from 7 PM in the evening until 7

AM the following morning. Crews will work Sunday through Saturday for approximately two weeks. There is potential for construction-related congestion during this portion of the project, so motorists would be wise to plan ahead and consider alternate routes if travel is time-sensitive.

Project impacts may include:

- Sidewalk closures
- Noise, dust, vibrations
- Some right hand turn lanes may be temporarily closed
- Some driveways may have
