Main Street Construction Has Begun

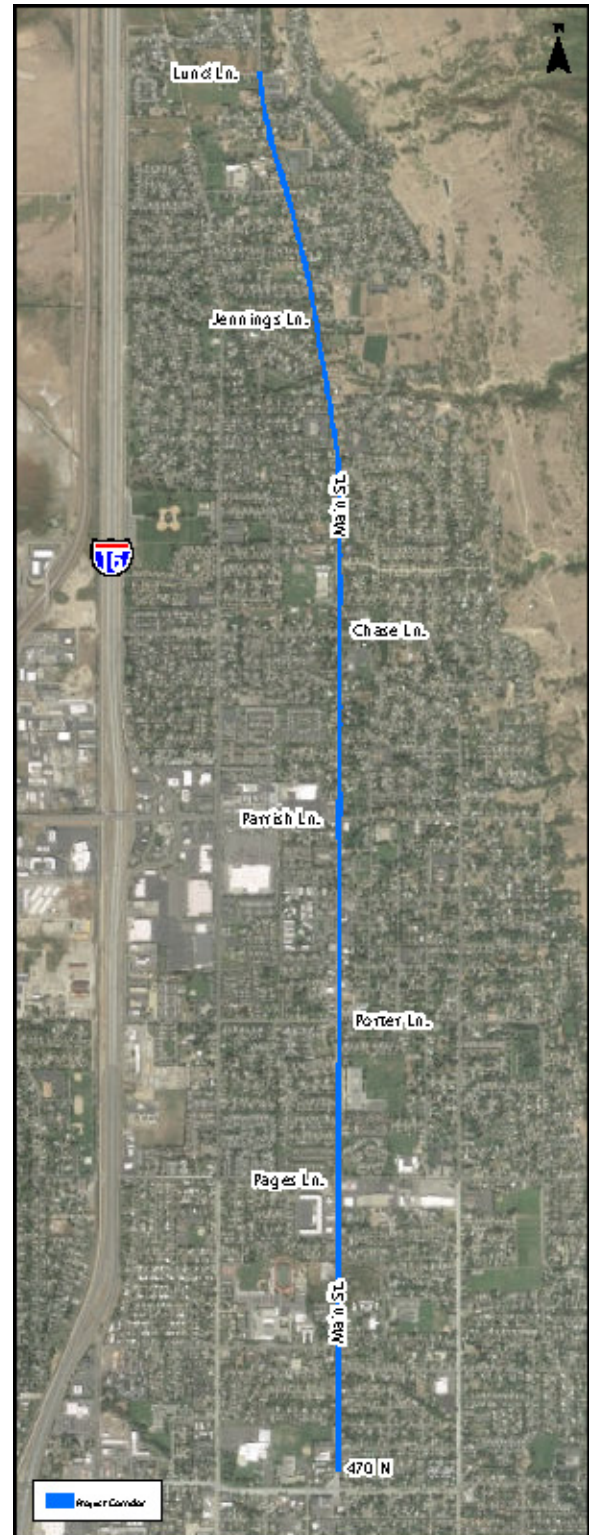
UDOT has started construction on SR-106 (Main Street) from 400 North in Bountiful to 1700 South in Farmington. Travel lanes will continue to be shifted to the west side of the road, with one lane of traffic open in each direction, while crews complete initial utility work, repair sidewalks, and begin work on the pedestrian ramps. Crews are working from south to north, so please pay attention to changing traffic patterns and be alert to workers and equipment in the work zone. Construction is anticipated to last through early August 2019.

UDOT is aware of the South Davis Triathlon happening on Saturday that will use Main Street as part of the race. The contractor will move traffic control devices so that Main Street is available for the race.

This project will rehabilitate the pavement by replacing the top layer of asphalt to preserve the life of the road and provide a smoother driving surface for the public. The project will also reconstruct ADA pedestrian ramps, install drainage improvements, replace roadway signs, and complete spot repairs on the sidewalks.
