Spring Clean Up

Our Spring Clear Up dates are April 3-7, 2023.



- Items must be out by 7:00
 a.m. on your garbage
 day.
- Bundles, bags or boxes must not exceed 50 lbs.
- Limbs and trees must be cut into 5' lengths and tied with twine.
- Landfill is free to Bountiful residents (proof of residency required) April 3-15.
- Different crews will be picking up different types of items.
- Construction materials will not be picked up curbside.

Power Up!

Bountiful City has entered into a 25-year power purchase agreement for solar power through UAMPS with the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority Generation-Utah, LLC, a subsidiary of Navajo Tribal Utility Authority ("NTUA") in southeastern Utah. The facility will begin commercial operation mid-March 2023. This will be equivalent to installing 580 roof top solar systems and will supply approximately 5% of the City's total power needs.

NTUA will use some proceeds from the project to support electrification on the Navajo Nation, such as its Light Up Navajo! Initiative.

Notice of Municipal Election

Bountiful City will hold a Municipal General Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2023. Three City Council members are to be voted on. The candidate filing period will be 8:00 a.m. -5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday, between June 1 and 7, 2023. All candidates must file in person in the City Recorder's office (795 South Main Street, Bountiful, Utah).

Candidates must meet the following qualifications: 1. Be a United States citizen

 Be a United States Citizen
 Be a registered voter of the City
 Be a resident of Bountiful City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the election
 Not be a convicted felon, unless their right to hold elective office has been restored.

What's an ADU?

ADU stands for Accessory Dwelling Unit and is essentially a second small dwelling on the same property as a single-family home. By definition, it's a self-contained dwelling unit within an owneroccupied single-family residence or in a detached accessory structure located on an owner-occupied property.

Examples include an apartment over a garage, a tiny home on a foundation in the backyard, or a basement apartment. These units are not bought or sold separately. These units may serve multiple purposes, such as additional income, future home for owner wanting to downsize and rent the main house or support family in need of housing.

Bountiful City allows ADUs, both internal and external (detached) units subject to meeting code requirements. Detached ADUs are also considered a conditional use and require Bountiful City Administrative Committee approval. Internal ADUs are reviewed and approved by City Staff.
