Temporary Sign Regulations

Bountiful City knows signs are important to your business. They help advertise sales, relay contact numbers, and even let the public know who you are and where you are located. It is our hope that this list can serve to remind you of common sign violations. By meeting the Code we not only ensure that everyone is playing by the same rules, but also this prevents The City Code Enforcement from removing any illegally placed signs.



All permanent signs <u>require</u> a sign permit; the sign permit application can be found on the Bountiful City Website under Doing Business. More information about signage requirements can be found in Chapter 19 of the *City Land Use Ordinance* available on the City Website.

A lot of businesses decide to use temporary signs to raise their profile. While temporary signs are allowed, you will want to make sure you are complying with the list below to ensure you don't have your signs taken down by the City.

- * A temporary sign shall be a banner, wall sign, A-Frame sign, or pedestal type sign. No other type of sign is permitted.
- * In Bountiful City, signs cannot be placed in a park strip. A park strip is a strip of grass that runs between a road and sidewalk. (A-Frame signs may be placed in the park strip directly in front of their business if the sign is removed each evening).
- * A-Frame signs are permitted, but they must be taken down each day, and should not obstruct a public right of way or sidewalk.
- * Temporary signs may not be taller than 6 feet and fin/blade signs are not permitted in the City of Bountiful.
- * Temporary signs shall not be illuminated, flash, blink, spin, rotate, block traffic visibility or create a public nuisance.
