### **S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful; 800 West to Main Street September 8, 2016**

#### **BUSINESSES ARE OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION!!!**

**Don't forget to support local businesses on 400 North.**

#### **TRAFFIC SHIFT PLANNED SEPTEMBER 18; 200 West to I-15**

As early as September 18, or as soon as the concrete reaches strength, crews plan to shift westbound traffic to the new concrete between 200 West and I-15. Eastbound traffic will remain on the south side.

- Activities following the traffic shift will include asphalt removal, roadway excavation, materials hauling and placement through October.

#### **400 North- Main Street to 500 West (Phase 1):**

- As early as Saturday, September 10, crews are scheduled to pour concrete at night between 350 West and 500 West on the north side of 400 North.
  - Concrete curb, gutter, and driveway approach reconstruction is scheduled to occur during the week of September 12.
  - North-side access will be restored as soon as the concrete reaches strength.
- As early as Monday, September 12, crews are scheduled to place concrete paving at the intersection of Main Street and 400 North and the eastern project limits on the south side of 400 North.
  - Pedestrian access will be maintained.
  - Access to Intermountain Bountiful Clinic will be maintained off Main Street.
  - Residents can expect an increase in noise and truck traffic during this work.

#### **Ongoing Activities:**

- Crews continue excavating, milling and drainage activities on the south side of 400 North between Main Street and 200 West through September.
  - Business access to Bountiful Antiques, Gordon's Copyprint LC, and FiiZ Drinks will be maintained during this work.
  - Residents can expect an increase in noise and traffic during this time.
  - Intermittent side street closures up to two hours may occur while work moves through intersections.

## 400 North- 500 West to I-15 (Phase 2):

- Tonight, Thursday, September 8, crews are scheduled to pour roadway concrete at night between 500 West and I-15 on the north side of 400 North.
- Concrete curb, gutter, and driveway approach reconstruction is scheduled to begin the week of September 19.
  - Business access will be maintained while the concrete cures. Use the 500 West access for businesses on the northwest corner of the intersection including Ramblin' Roads, Elks Lodge, and the Downunder Club. Eldredge Manor will remain accessible from 400 North.

## Project Description:

The project will reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance. Additionally, the project will:

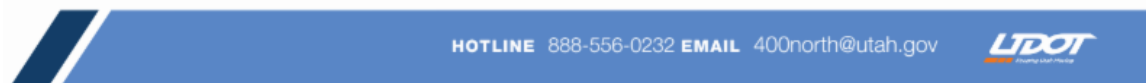
- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street.
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow.

## Project Impacts:

- 400 North is reduced to one lane in each direction between Main Street and I-15.
- Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect access restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise during the day and at night.
- Pedestrians should be alert, follow posted signs, and use an alternate route when possible.
- Through the duration of this project, trash pick-up days have been changed to every Friday between 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the entire corridor. To maintain trash removal while work continues, crews will move trash bins to the other side of the street every Friday morning at 8 a.m. To ensure bins are moved, residents must place their bins on the sidewalk by 6 p.m. the evening prior.
