Overview:

Under direct supervision of the Sanitation Supervisor, the Sanitation Light Equipment Operator will operate a refuse collection truck on an assigned daily route transporting refuse to the Landfill with care and safety for themselves and residents.

Essential Responsibilities:

1. Due to overlapping responsibilities in Streets, Storm Water, Sanitation and Landfill, this position's duties must overlap to accommodate these needs. A Light Equipment Operator may work in any of the four divisions although their main area of responsibility is Sanitation.
2. Runs assigned garbage route daily in a timely manner.
3. Performs cleaning and maintenance of sanitation equipment.
4. Delivers and maintains containers on the assigned route.
5. Performs manual labor in all areas of the department, as necessary. Must be able to lift a minimum of 75 lbs. Job performance shall follow Bountiful City Policies and Procedures.
6. Requires competence in the operation and safety of sanitation, streets, landfill, and storm water vehicles or assigned equipment.
7. Performs all department duties as requested by a supervisor including snow plowing and problems requiring overtime.
8. Must be on 24 hours call out for emergencies.
9. Regular attendance at work required.

Critical Skills-Expertise:

Must have and maintain a valid Utah Class "A" CDL driver's license or obtain one with 90 days of hire date. Training available on site for equipment operation and CDL license.
Must be able to operate sanitation vehicles and snowplows in a safe and efficient manner.

Necessary Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

1. Must have considerable knowledge of equipment and operating principles and procedures.
3. Must have considerable knowledge of safety requirements and hazards relating to equipment operation.
4. Ability to work and perform under adverse weather conditions.
5. Ability to perform minor equipment maintenance and repair.

Education and Experience:

Graduation from a standard senior high school or equivalent.
