Overview:

Under direct supervision of the Streets Supervisor, the light equipment operator performs labor for street repairs and snow plowing at the Bountiful City Streets Department.

Tasks:

Due to the overlapping responsibilities in the street, sanitation, storm water, and landfill departments, this position must accommodate those needs. The Equipment Operator may work in any of the four divisions although the main area of responsibility is to the hired position. This position requires the employee to become competent in the operation and safety of storm water, sanitation, street, and landfill vehicles or equipment as assigned. Cleans and maintains all equipment. Uses safety barricading as needed and assists with traffic control and paving operations. Performs manual labor in all areas of the department as necessary and as requested by the supervisor, including snow plowing and often working overtime.

Knowledge, Skills and Other Characteristics:

Must be self-motivated and be able to take responsibility for assigned projects.
Must be on 24 hour call out for emergencies and live within a 20 minute response time area.
Must attend work regularly.
Ability to work and perform under adverse conditions.
Must be able to lift a minimum of 75 lbs.
Job performance shall follow City of Bountiful policies and procedures.
Ability to perform minor equipment maintenance and repair.
Ability to operate storm water, sanitation vehicles and snow plows in a safe, efficient manner.
Ability to communicate with other employees' job needs and functions.

Qualifications:

Graduation from a standard high school or equivalent.
Must have considerable knowledge of equipment and operating principles and procedures.
Must have and maintain a valid Utah Class "B" CDL driver's license.
Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug test, and a criminal background and driving record check.
