39 **CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE BOND ELECTION RESULTS AS PREPARED BY**
40 **THE DAVIS COUNTY CLERK/AUDITOR'S OFFICE – MR. GARY HILL**

41 Mr. Hill presented the results of the City of Bountiful Park & Recreation Bond Election
42 to the Council, along with the description of ballots not counted and the Statement of Votes Cast
43 (SOVC). He pointed out that voter turn out was 91.85% in this election which is very high. The
44 results of the election were 14,424 votes for the bond and 9, 873 votes against the bond.

1 Councilwoman Bradshaw made a motion to approve the results of the City of Bountiful
2 Park & Recreation Bond Election as prepared by the Davis County Clerk/Auditor's office and
3 Councilwoman Harris seconded the motion. The motion was approved with Councilmembers
4 Bradshaw, Harris, Higginson and Simonsen voting "aye".
