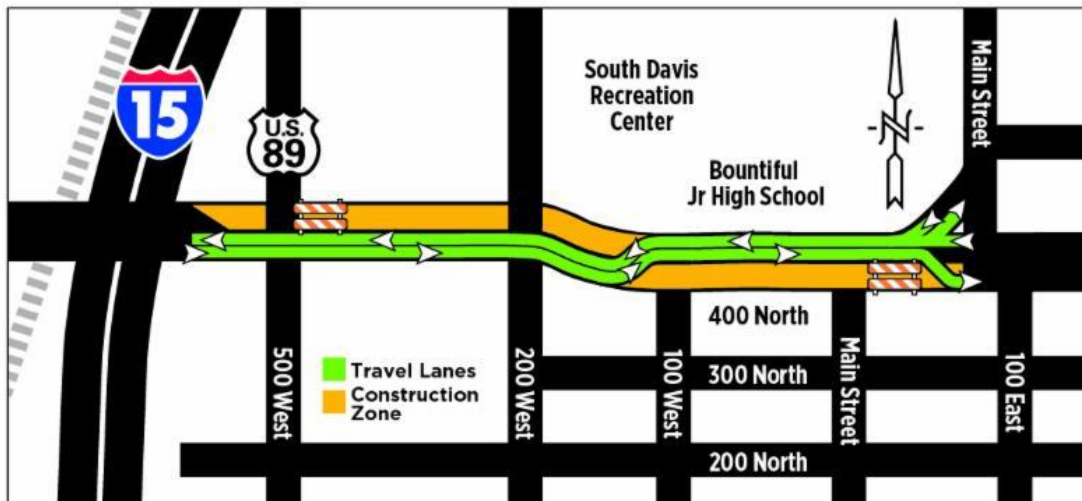
400 North Improved Project Update- July 28, 2016

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is resurfacing S.R. 106 (400 North) in Bountiful from 800 West to Main Street to increase the life the roadway.

Construction Activities for July 28- August 4, 2016

400 North- Main Street to 500 West (Phase 1): Work is ongoing on the north side of the street, starting at Main Street and moving west towards I-15 through July.

This week:

- As early as Friday, July 29 crews will work on pouring concrete driveway approaches east of 17 E. and Main Street to 455 North.
 - Residents are asked to park at an alternate location for up to 10 days to allow concrete to cure and reach strength. Residents will be notified when driveway accesses are available.
- As early as Friday, July 29 crews are scheduled to pour concrete curb and gutter between 200 West and 325 West. Concrete curb and gutter work between 325 W. and 500 W. is scheduled for early August.

- Residents are asked to park at an alternate location for up to 10 days for each pouring activity and to allow concrete to cure.
- Parking is available for these residents at the Utah State Liquor Store on 500 W. from 7:30 PM to 7 AM, Mike Sterling's Flooring America from 6 PM to 9 AM and Community Chiropractic (395 N. 200 W.) from 7 PM to 7 AM.

400 North- 500 West to I-15 (Phase 2):

Work during this phase will begin on the south side of 400 North and move from east to west.

- Crews continue work on the south side of 400 N. between Main Street and 200 W. Crews will begin reconstructing manholes along this section in early August.
 - Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
- As early as August 4th, crews are scheduled to pour concrete roadway from Main Street to 200 West with curb and gutter following.
 - Residents can expect an increase in heavy truck traffic and noise.
 - Concrete pouring will occur at night. Driveways in this segment will be closed for approximately 10 days while the concrete cures. Please begin making preparations to park in an alternate location.

400 North- West of I-15 to 800 West (Phase 3):

Work during this phase will begin east of 800 West and 400 North and move towards the west side of 500 West. During this work, intermittent, single lane traffic from I-15 to 800 West is anticipated.

- Milling activities are anticipated to occur in August beginning at I-15 and heading west on the north side of 400 North.
- Concrete paving work is scheduled to follow in mid-August.
 - Residents can expect to park in an alternate location while concrete cures.
 - Expect congestion and traffic delays of up to ten minutes.
- Crews are scheduled to shift traffic in early August between I-15 and 800 West on the north side of 400 North in preparation for milling activities to begin on the south side of 400 North.

Project Description:

The project will reconstruct the roadway in concrete for a longer pavement life and less future maintenance. Additionally, the project will:

- Add new curb, gutter, and some sidewalk and driveway approaches from 500 West to Main Street.
- Add radar detection at the 400 North/200 West intersection to improve traffic flow.

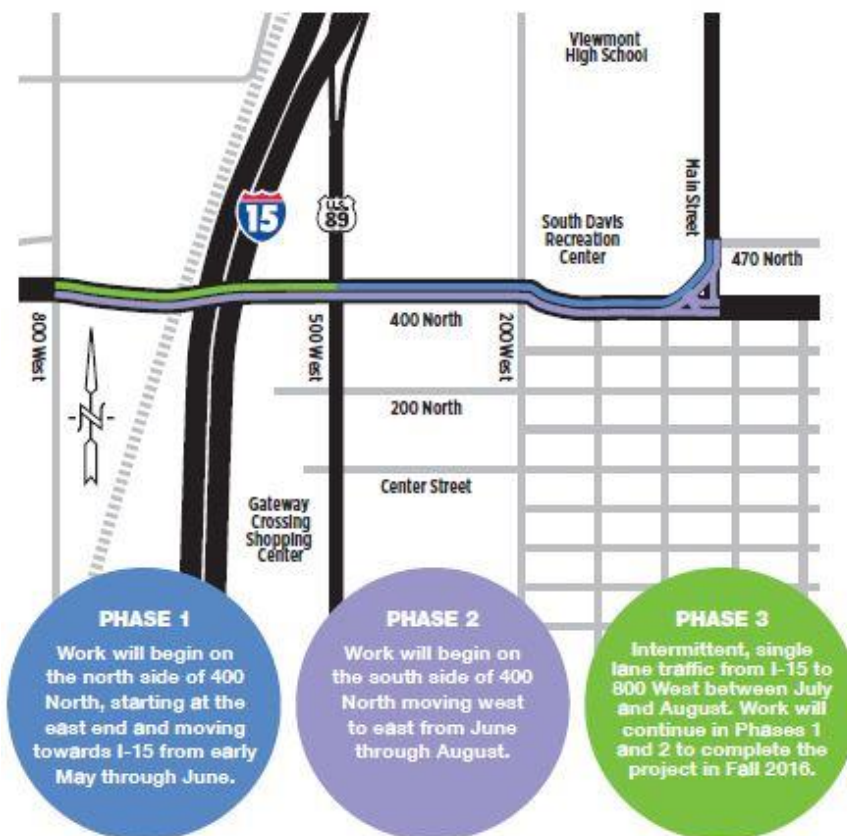
Project Impacts:

- 400 North reduced to one lane in each direction between Main Street and 500 West.
- Motorists should be prepared for significant delays and use alternate routes when possible.
- Area residents and businesses can expect short-term intermittent driveway interruptions.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise during the day and at night.

- Motorists can reduce delays by using alternate routes, avoiding peak travel times, telecommuting, carpooling or combining trips. Pedestrians should be alert and follow posted signs. It is recommended that an alternate route be used.
- Through the duration of this project, trash pick-up days have been changed to every Friday between 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for the entire corridor. To maintain trash removal while work continues, crews will move trash bins to the other side of the street every Friday morning at 8 a.m. To ensure bins are moved, residents must place their bins on the sidewalk by 6 p.m. the evening prior.

Project Timeline:

Construction began in mid May and is scheduled to continue through October 2016. This aggressive construction schedule was designed to work around the Bountiful City water line and irrigation project currently underway and complete work in one construction season.
