



Bountiful City Response to COVID-19

Updated: May 14, 2020

As the effect of coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to evolve, Bountiful City is closely monitoring the situation and complying with recommendations given by the State of Utah, the Davis County Health Department and CDC. Protecting the health and safety of our employees and residents is our highest priority while we work to provide as many city services as possible during this time. Current updates to be aware of include: (recent updates are marked in red):

Update: By Executive Order from the Governor, parts of the state, including Davis County, are moving from moderate risk (orange) to low risk (yellow) in the Utah Leads COVID-19 health guidance system, effective May 16. Many answers to your questions can be found here: [Utah's Low Risk Phase](#).

- **Update:** City parks information: (to align with guidelines provided in [Utah's Low Risk Phase](#).)
 - Effective May 16, all playgrounds are open. Visitors should limit child interaction with other children in public spaces (e.g. playground equipment); a 6-foot distance should be maintained.
 - Park restrooms will open soon, once additional cleaning and repairs have been completed.
 - Sports fields and courts (including pickleball) are open. Remember to remain at least 6 feet apart from individuals from other households while engaging in outdoor activities (e.g., pickleball, tennis, walking, hiking, running, bicycling, hunting, fishing, etc.).
 - Do not touch high-touch surfaces, including handrails, trail signs, maps.
 - Do not congregate at trailheads, parks, or other outdoor spaces.
- Bountiful City offices remain staffed and open, but we encourage residents to make every effort to conduct business via phone, e-mail, or online. No public tours of City facilities will be permitted at this time. [View City Phone Directory here](#).

 - Canceled: Bountiful's Got Talent, Handcart Days parade & park activities (July 17-18)
 - Postponed: Chalk Art Festival: now September 16-19
