## It's Official - Fiber is Coming to Bountiful

Bountiful City and UTOPIA Fiber, an Open Access fiber network, announce a pioneering partnership model. Bountiful Fiber, powered by UTOPIA, represents the first-of-its-kind collaboration in the state, with Bountiful City taking ownership of the Open Access network while UTOPIA serves as the operating partner.

The partnership between UTOPIA Fiber and Bountiful City signifies a new model that aims to ensure Bountiful residents and businesses benefit from fast, reliable, and affordable fiber-optic internet connectivity, while leveraging UTOPIA's expertise and proven track record in network operation and maintenance.

Highlights of the partnership include:

- Bountiful City will own the fiber infrastructure, UTOPIA Fiber will build and operate the system.
- Funded through subscriber revenues at no cost to the taxpayer.
- Construction should begin in the next few months with a 24-36 month estimated completion.
- Bountiful will be the second largest city in Utah to partner with UTOPIA Fiber

## Change in Municipal Election Dates



Representative Chris Stewart has resigned his seat in the US House of Representatives, necessitating a special election to replace him. To accommodate that, Governor Cox signed a resolution in June changing the dates of the Municipal Primary and General Elections this year as follows:

The Primary Election will be held **Tuesday, September 5**, and the General Election will be held **Tuesday, November 21**. Ballots for both elections will be mailed out three weeks prior to the election date.
