About the Planning Commission

The Planning Commission was created pursuant to Utah Code and advises the City on land use and development matters, including Conditional Use Permits, Variances, Architectural and Site Plan Review, Land Use Code Text Amendments, Zone Changes, General Plan updates, and other community planning matters.

With the adoption of the **Bountiful By Design General Plan** in December 2025, the Planning Commission will play a pivotal role in implementing the new plan, including upcoming Land Use Code Text Amendments and Zone Changes that will help shape the future of the community.

 2. Please describe your connection to the Bountiful community, including any community involvement, service, or perspective you would bring to the Commission.
 3. What do you perceive as the mission of the Planning Commission?
 4. What specific skills, experience, or qualities would you bring to the Commission?

A résumé is optional. Please attach it to the email. The City may request a short interview with the Mayor and Planning Director.
