Current Work

The US-89 Eagle Ridge to I-15 construction project is nearly buttoned up. With just a few punch list items remaining, full project completion is expected by early September.

Approximately four miles of asphalt received a micro-surface treatment, extending the life of the highway. Many street and traffic signs were replaced, crosswalks and pavement markings were repainted, and pedestrian ramps have been upgraded to meet federal standards.



Microsurfacing work along US-89 from Eagle Ridge Drive to the I-15 connection is complete.

A big thanks to pedestrians, cyclists and motorists for your cooperation as construction crews worked to make US-89 safer.

Traffic Alerts

Impacts to the following areas are anticipated.

US-89 Eagle Ridge Drive north to I-15 entrance

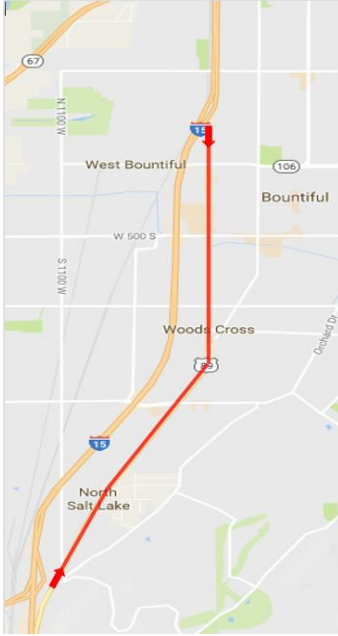
- Temporary and intermittent closures of right and left turns, median and driveway access may be in place
- Delays and congestion are possible

What can I expect during construction?

Project impacts may include:

- Sidewalk closures
- Noise, dust, vibrations
- Some right-hand turn lanes on US-89 may be temporarily closed

- Some driveways may have access impacted while work takes place
- Minor traffic delays, lane shifts and single lane closures on US-89



Project Overview

UDOT will be performing asphalt maintenance on a four mile corridor on US-89 through Bountiful, West Bountiful, Woods Cross and North Salt Lake (from Eagle Ridge Drive to 1000 North/I-15). The pavement will receive a micro-surface treatment, which will extend the life of the asphalt.

The project will also be upgrading approximately 100 sidewalk pedestrian ramps to become compliant with federal Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Work on pedestrian ramps began at the south end of the project limits, and crews plan to work their way north. Construction work is scheduled for completion by the end of August.
